

NOTICE OF EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Irrigation District Manager

Job description: Goshen Irrigation District is seeking a full-time manager to lead and manage irrigation water deliveries and system maintenance to GID water users. The Manager, with the approval of the Board of Commissioners, shall have general charge of the District and the employment of personnel. The manager will lead a staff of 20 and will oversee all aspects of GID including: employee management, irrigation water deliveries; maintenance, repairs, and upkeep of the irrigation system; local and state representation; reporting to the Board of Commissioners and many other duties as seen fit by the Board.

Responsibilities:

The District Manager has the following responsibilities and duties:

- Employee Management
- Enforcing the By-Laws of the District
- Delivering Water to Irrigation Users during the Water Season
- Attendance of all Board Meetings
- Communicating with local, state and federal agencies and officials regarding water deliveries and District business.
- Ensuring proper maintenance and upkeep of District facilities & systems.
- Completing all tasks and actions requested by the Board of Commissioners.
- Ability to communicate and respond to landowner concerns or needs.
- Public relation skills and ability for cooperation and leadership at local, state and regional levels to promote and represent the District as needed.

Requirements:

Applicant should have the following skills, education, and experience:

- Minimum High School Graduate, College Degree Preferred
- Understanding of production agriculture and current irrigation practices
- Understanding of local state and federal water laws
- Possess Basic Computer Skills – Email Correspondence, MS Word and Excel.
- Knowledge of Irrigation Water measurements, diversions, and canal systems.
- Prior Management Experience
- Employee Management Experience
- Active in the Agricultural Industry/Prior Agricultural Industry Experience

Goshen Irrigation District's mission: GID manages 84 miles of main canal, across Goshen County to the state line with over 200 miles of laterals and drain ditches. The District

consists of 52,848 acres of water rights from the North Platte River, Pathfinder Reservoir and Guernsey Reservoir and is governed by a Board of five Commissioners elected from landowners in the District. GID is dedicated to delivering irrigation water to its users in the most efficient, affordable, and timely way possible during the irrigation season while repairing and improving its District system annually.
